

LIFE MEMBERSHIP PLANS

Paid Life Membership Plan – At the Annual Meeting in June, 1991, Life Membership Plans were discussed. A Paid Life Membership Plan was approved for members desiring to use this plan, prior to becoming 90 years of age, **and** who have been members for five consecutive years. The following schedule for Paid Life Memberships was approved in July 2001 at the convention.

Upon Request Honorary Life Membership

At the 2003 Annual Meeting, it was voted to change our Bylaws to include spouses in Paid Life Memberships.

Honorary Life Membership Plan – The FPRA Bylaws outline the following provisions; all members 90 years of age, or over; and who have paid dues for five or more consecutive years prior to their 90th birthday, will be considered for an Honorary Life Membership Plan. The membership is free. As the FPRA does not have birth dates or ages on file, a request for Honorary Life Membership is necessary.
